

Pointers for Participating in Poster Competition at ICAS 2022

The India Clean Air Summit (ICAS) is a national flagship event on Air Pollution organised by the Centre for Air Pollution Studies (CAPS) at CSTEP. The event embraces an integrative and holistic approach to improving India's Air Quality. This year, ICAS—in collaboration with ASIC, UC Davis—will be held from 24 to 26 August, focusing on the theme of 'Looking at air pollution through the climate lens'.

The Student Poster Competition at the ICAS-ASIC conference will give graduate students, researchers, and PhD scholars working in the field of Air Pollution and Climate Change an opportunity to present their ideas and research to a global audience. Being a hybrid event, the participants will be able to engage and network with experts and organisations across multiple platforms.

Rules for Abstract submission

Abstract format:-

- 1st line: Title of the abstract.
- 2nd line: Name(s) of the author(s)
- 3rd line: Affiliation of the author(s)
- 4th line: Email ID of the corresponding author(s)
- One blank line, followed by the abstract text (maximum 250 words)
- Abstract submission last date: 25 May
- Submission of the abstracts by email to: icas@cstep.in

Rules for Extended Paper submission

- From the submitted abstracts, 30 teams will be selected, who will then be asked to submit a full paper. The selected teams will be intimated via email.
- Full paper submission deadline 15 June
- The extended paper can be a maximum of 1000 words, including figures and tables.
- Submission of the full paper to be emailed to: icas@cstep.in
- The papers will be selected on the basis of their originality and relevance of the research.



Rules for Poster competition

- 15 teams will be selected for presenting their research at the ICAS 2022 event in Bengaluru.
- Poster submission deadline 1 July
- The selected 15 teams also need to submit a 2-minute video along with the posters in one folder. The folder should be titled 'Name Affiliation' of the participants.

Registration

- The selected teams would have to register via a registration link shared later over email.
- The selected teams would have to pay a registration charge of INR 3000 per head (national participants); INR 5000 per head (international participants).

Accommodation and Travel:

- For each team, a maximum of 2 people are allowed in person to present their work at the event.
- For national students, travel (3rd class AC) and accommodation will be provided to the selected teams.
- For international students, only accommodation will be provided to the selected teams.

Other Guidelines:

- The posters will be printed by CSTEP and teams need not bring any hard copy of the poster.
- The template for the poster will be shared with the selected 15 Teams in advance.
- If any teams/members cannot present their work at the event in person, the prerecorded 2-min video of their poster will be presented, and they would have the option of interacting with the audience virtually.
- Students need to be available during the event to answer queries (online and offline) from participants at ICAS2022.
